The International Vintage Motorcycle Show and Swap Meet is held annually on the 3rd weekend of August. The event moved to a permanent home at the Outagamie County Fairgrounds in 2007 so as to have a better layout for vendors, closer access to hotels, and to accommodate vintage racing. The event annually fills hundreds of vendor spaces, draws thousands of spectators, and is the national event of the Vintage Japanese and European Motorcycle Club of North America, Inc.

SPECTATOR HOURS:

Friday, August 14--10AM to 8PM
Saturday, August 15--8AM to 8PM
Sunday, August 16--8AM to 3PM

ADMISSION - SWAP MEET

\$7 per adult daily. Children 12 and under will be admitted free with an adult.

SPECTATOR PARKING

Free parking for spectators arriving in cars and motorcycles is available by entering the grounds through gate 2, at the northeast end of the grounds on State Highway 55

All motorcycles will be able to park in the special motorcycle area immediately next to the swap area. Turn left once you pay your admission fee at the gate!

REGISTRATION FOR SHOW BIKES, BIKE CORRAL, SWAP MEET, and CAMPING

Advance registration is strongly urged. By pre-registering, we can assure space will be available to accommodate you. Vendors will also not have to stop at the gate for more than a few seconds, as you will simply show your passes and drive in, avoiding long lines. Preregistered participants will receive confirmations upon receipt of registration, and passes in July of 2009.

VINTAGE MOTORCYCLE SHOW-CONCOURS JUDGING AND PEOPLES' CHOICE AWARDS

Vintage motorcycles of all makes, models, and nationalities are welcome to enter the vintage motorcycle show. All show bikes will be indoors and secured overnight. There will be awards for both concours judging and peoples' choice. Categories will be Japanese, European, British, American, and Vintage Customs. All bikes must be 1994 or older, to meet the VJEMC's vintage standard. The registration fee is \$6 per bike entered in the show. All bikes must be entered by Saturday at 3PM. Judging will take place on Saturday and Sunday.

BIKE CORRAL

At the center of the swap meet, a bike corral will be available for those people wishing to sell a motorcycle. It must be driveable. Enter at Gate 2. The fee is \$6 per bike to sell a bike in the corral.

SWAP MEET

The meet has over 2,000 available vendor sites that average 20 feet by 20 feet. Swap meet spaces are for motorcycle related items only. No food or beverage items can be sold. Spaces for pre-registered vendors are \$45. There is a \$5 discount per space for VJEMC members. Any remaining spaces on event day, if available, are \$60.

WANT FREE VENDOR SPACES FOR 2010 AND BEYOND?

Then register in advance for 2009!

Those who pay and register in advance for the 2009 IVMS & SM will be able to receive their spaces for free in 2010 and beyond. Our goal is to always build the event and continue to increase the number of vendors. With added sponsor dollars, we want to pass the savings on to the vendors, who are the key cog in the event! While at the 2009 event, you will receive a form before the close of the event that will allow you to claim your free space, which you can turn in before you leave. This form will have all of the details for free space for 2010 and beyond. Your space can be the same one you will have for 2009, have had in the past (if available) or a different one if one is available!

Electric swap meet spaces are also available. These are \$65 per space. There is a \$5 discount for VJEMC members. Any remaining spaces on event day, if available, are \$80.

SWAP MEET ENTRY

Use Gate 3 on Eagle Street. Vendor entry will begin on Friday, August 14 at 7AM until close on Friday night. Vendor entry continues on Saturday August 15 at 7AM and goes until noon. There will be no new vendor entry on Sunday. All vendors should exit through Gate 3 when leaving on Sunday as well. Vendors leaving earlier than 2PM on Sunday will forfeit their rights to their same spaces for 2010.

CAMPING

Camping is available on the north end of the grounds. Electrical and water hookups are available. Camping will be a 20 foot by 30 foot space, and is \$30 per space pre-registered. There is a \$5 discount for VJEMC members. Any remaining spaces on event days, if available, are \$45. Enter at Gate 2. Rather than assign you a numbered space, campers will be placed as they arrive. Your advance reservation will guarantee you a spot!

Showers will be available on the grounds.

Quiet hours are from 11PM to 6AM as a courtesy to everyone.

Campfires - By local ordinance, campfires are NOT allowed.

ENTRY GATES

Gate 2 - Spectators on motorcycles, motorcycles entering the vintage motorcycle shows, motorcycles registering for the bike corral, and riders/motorcycles participating in the event charity rides on Saturday and Sunday, as well as all campers and spectator cars/trucks.

Gate 3 - Vendor entry/exit only!

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Food service will be available from 8AM to the end of the races on Friday, 8AM to 8PM on Saturday, and 8AM-2PM on Sunday. Brats, hamburgers, hot dogs, soda, water, beer, chips, nachos, popcorn, and more will be available at reasonable prices.

WHERE IS SEYMOUR, WISCONSIN???

From the north-From WI Hwy 29, take WI HWY 55 south to Seymour.

From the west-Take WI HWY 54 to Seymour and turn left on HWY 55 through downtown Seymour

From the east-Take WI HWY 54 from Green Bay and turn right on HWY 55 through downtown Seymour

From the south-Take US HWY 41 to the HWY 55 exit in Kaukauna. Go north (left) through the town of Freedom. Turn left on HWY 54 (which runs together with 55) and then turn right on HWY 55 through downtown Seymour.

Charity Ride: Register at Gate 2 on the day of the ride

Fee is \$10 for single riders, and \$15 for two-up.

Saturday August 15-The ride is for any make, model, and age of motorcycle. This will be a 75-100 mile ride beginning at 1PM. There will be 1-2 stops on the route, and a free meal for all registered riders after the ride.

Swap Meet - Enter Gate 3

Regular Spaces - Space sizes are mostly 20 feet by 20 feet, with a few just slightly smaller. Cost is \$45 per space, and \$40 for VJEMC members. Any open spaces (if available) will be \$60 on show weekend per space.

Electrical Spaces - Space sizes are mostly 20 feet by 20 feet, with a few just slightly smaller. Cost is \$65 per space, and \$60 for VJEMC members. Any open spaces (if available) will be \$80 on show weekend per space.

Free Motorcycle Club Display Spaces - Enter Gate 2

These spaces are free to motorcycle clubs approved by show directors for participation. Vintage clubs will get first priority, or clubs which will bring older motorcycles. You are required to bring motorcycles or memorabilia for **display only**. Nothing may be sold in these spaces except for club tee shirts and memberships. Free giveaways are fine as well. A fee will be charged at the gate for admittance, but there is no charge for the space. Contact the show office at 877-853-6210 to inquire about space for your club needs.

Bike Corral - Enter Gate 2

\$6.00 registration fee. This is for running motorcycles of any age that you wish to sell. No parts or parts bikes. Additional spectator fee at the gate. \$10 if registering on show weekend.
